Course Description with Learning Objectives:

This half-day seminar provides a comprehensive review of the 2017 edition of *NFPA 25*. Upon completion, attendees will be able to state the scope of the standard, identify owner's responsibilities, describe requirements for record keeping, and recognize the liabilities associated with performing this work. The significant changes from the 2014 edition will be highlighted along with how to apply the requirements of the standard. Attendees will participate in discussions regarding the inspection and testing of wet and dry sprinkler systems, standpipe and hose systems, fire pumps, and the associated valves used in these systems. Attendees will leave the seminar with a greater understanding of how to apply the requirements for all water-based systems.
